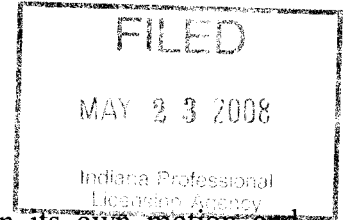

**ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE**

Comes now the Indiana Board of Pharmacy (Board), on its own motion and pursuant to IC 4-21.5, and hereby ORDERS Respondent Donnielle Shead to appear before the Board on June 9, 2008 at 1:00 p.m. local time, in the Indiana Government Center South, Conference Room A, located at 302 West Washington Street, Indianapolis, Indiana 46204.

1. Respondent is to show cause why Respondent's pharmacy technician certification should not be summarily suspended, on an emergency basis, or whether other disciplinary action should be imposed due to noncompliance with the probationary terms as set forth in the Board's July 14, 2005 Decision On Certification Application which is attached hereto as Exhibit A, in that Respondent violated the terms of her probation. Respondent Shead (a) failed to maintain her contract with the Indiana Pharmacists Recovery Network (PRN) which has been terminated by PRN; (b) failed to make monthly probationary appearances to the Board; (c) failed to comply with all statutes and rules regulating pharmacy; (d) and failed to submit supervisor reports addressing her work habits, job performance, professional competence, sense of responsibility, attitude and ability to work with others.

4. The official cause number of this action is 2005 IBP 0036.
5. The Board is empowered to hold this disciplinary hearing pursuant to the authority of IC 25-1-9 and IC 4-21.5.

8. A party who fails to attend or participate in a prehearing conference, hearing, or other later stage of this proceeding may be held in default or have the proceeding dismissed pursuant to IC 4-21.5-3-24.
