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NOTICE OF PROPOSED DISMISSAL ORDER

An administrative hearing was scheduled to be held before the Indiana Board of Pharmacy ("Board") on August 13, 2012 in Room W064 of the Indiana Government Center South, located at 402 West Washington Street, Indianapolis, Indiana 46204, concerning the Petition of Donielle Shead, C.Ph.T. ("Petitioner") for reinstatement of her Indiana pharmacy technician license.

The State of Indiana was represented by Amanda R. Elizondo, Attorney for the State. Petitioner was not present in person or by counsel.

Pursuant to Ind. Code § 4-21.5-3-24, the Board voted 7-0-0 to issue a Notice of Proposed Dismissal Order on the following grounds:

1. Petitioner is a Pharmacy Technician in the State of Indiana holding license number 67008613A. Her license expired on June 30, 2008. Petitioner's address on file with the Indiana Professional Licensing Agency is 4060 North 150 West, Apartment E-13, Columbus, Indiana 47201.

2. On July 6, 2012, Petitioner petitioned the Board for reinstatement of her pharmacy technician license.

3. On July 19, 2012, the Indiana Professional Licensing Agency sent a hearing notice to Petitioner at her listed address, informing her of the time, date, and place of the administrative hearing on her petition scheduled for August 13, 2012.

4. Pursuant to Ind. Code § 4-21.5-3-20, Petitioner was provided adequate notice of the date and time of the final hearing and failed to appear for said hearing in person or by counsel on August 13, 2012.

ORDER


For Respondent's failure to appear for her scheduled hearing, the Board issues the following Notice of Proposed Dismissal:

In accordance with Ind. Code § 4-21.5-3-24, Petitioner must file a written motion within seven (7) days of service of this Order requesting that the Board not enter a dismissal order in this case and stating the reasons relied upon for that request. Failure of Petitioner to file such a written motion within seven (7) days shall result in the issuance of a dismissal order. If Petitioner timely files a motion, the Board shall consider said motion along with any relevant facts in determining whether a dismissal order should be entered. Should a dismissal order be entered against Petitioner, the Board may hold further proceedings it deems appropriate to complete this case without the participation of Petitioner.


