COMPLAINT

This complaint is brought against the pharmacy technician license of Amy Catherine Pitcher, C.Ph.T. (Respondent), by the Office of the Attorney General, by counsel, Deputy Attorney General Darren R. Covington, on behalf of the State of Indiana (Petitioner) and pursuant to Ind. Code § 25-1-7-7, Ind. Code § 25-1-5-3, Ind. Code ch. 25-26-13, the Administrative Orders and Procedures Act, Ind. Code art. 4-21.5 and Ind. Code ch. 25-1-9 and in support alleges and states:

FACTS

1. Respondent's address on file with the Indiana Professional Licensing Agency is 11607 Peacock Drive, Indianapolis, Indiana 46236.
2. Respondent is a licensed pharmacy technician in the State of Indiana having been issued license number 67009432A on May 30, 2006.
3. At all times relevant herein, Respondent was employed as a pharmacy technician with Dr. Aziz Pharmacy in Indianapolis, Indiana.
4. In January 2012, a customer of Dr. Aziz Pharmacy complained to the owner that she believed her credit card number on file with Dr. Aziz Pharmacy had been used by an employee to make unauthorized purchases.

5. During the investigation by the owner, Respondent admitted that she used the customer's credit card number to make purchases, and also admitted that she had done this one other time with another customer's credit card number. Respondent then submitted her resignation.

6. On or around March 20, 2012, Respondent was charged in Marion County, Indiana Superior Court with one count of Fraud, a Class D Felony, under Cause Number 49F15-1203-FD-017806.

7. On or around August 9, 2012, Respondent pled guilty to Fraud. Respondent received a one year suspended sentence, was ordered to complete 64 hours of community service, and pay restitution in the amount of \$938.39.

COUNT I

8. Paragraphs 1 through 7 are incorporated by reference herein.

9. Respondent violated Ind. Code § 25-1-9-4(a)(2)(A) and (B) in that Respondent has been convicted of a crime that has a direct bearing on her ability to practice competently and is harmful to the public as evidenced by her guilty plea to Fraud for the unauthorized use of a pharmacy customer's credit card.

WHEREFORE, Petitioner demands an order against the Respondent that:

1. Imposes the appropriate disciplinary sanction;
2. Directs Respondent to immediately pay all costs incurred in the prosecution of this case; and,
3. Provides any further relief as the Board deems just and proper.
