1. Respondent's conduct constitutes a violation of Ind. Code § 25-1-9-4(a)(10).


AGREED DISPOSITION

It is now therefore agreed by Respondent and Petitioner as follows:


1. The Board has jurisdiction over Respondent and the subject matter in this disciplinary action.
2. The parties execute this Agreement voluntarily.
3. Both parties voluntarily waive their rights to a public hearing on the Order to Show Cause.
4. Petitioner agrees the terms of this Agreement will resolve any and all pending claims or allegations relating to disciplinary action against Respondent's license.
5. Respondent's license shall be placed on **INDEFINITE SUSPENSION**.
6. Respondent may petition for reinstatement after **SEVEN (7) YEARS**.
7. Respondent has carefully read and examined this agreement and fully understands its terms and that, subject to a final order issued by the Board, this Agreement is a final disposition of all matters and not subject to further review.
8. Respondent further understands that a violation of the Final Order, any non-compliance with the statutes or regulations regarding the practice of pharmacy, or any violation

of this Agreement may result in Petitioner requesting a summary suspension of Respondent's license, an Order to Show Cause as may be issued by the Board, or a new cause pursuant to Ind. Code § 25-1-9-4, any or all of which could lead to additional penalties and including a revocation of Respondent's license.

9. The parties agree to the continuing jurisdiction of the Board as to discipline agreed to, terms of discipline, and licensure status will apply even if the Board rescinds Respondent's license at a later date.
