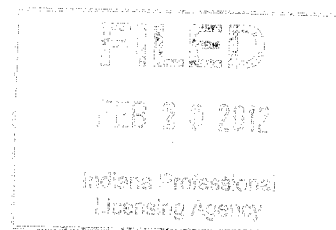

**DECISION ON APPLICATION FOR REGISTRATION AS A NONRESIDENT
PHARMACY**

The Indiana Board of Pharmacy ("Board") requested that representatives of Steven's Pharmacy ("Applicant") personally appear before the Board on February 13, 2012 for the purpose of providing information and answering questions concerning its application to be registered as a nonresident pharmacy in Indiana.

The Board, after considering the information presented by the Applicant and reviewing its file in this matter, votes 6 to 0 to issue the following Decision.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Steven's Pharmacy ("Steven's") does business at 1525 Mesa Verde Drive East, Costa Mesa, California 92626.
2. Steven's submitted an application to become registered as a nonresident pharmacy doing business in Indiana in an application submitted in 2011.
3. Along with the application, Steven's revealed that its license in California is on probation due to its failure to properly supervise a technician who diverted large quantities of controlled substances. The probation in California was imposed in June 2010 and is of three year's duration.

4. The Board is willing to register Steven's provided the registration is on probationary status and runs concurrently with the probation in California.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. Under Ind. Code § 25-26-17-2, Steven's is a nonresident pharmacy.
2. Under Ind. Code § 25-26-17-3, a nonresident pharmacy must register with the Board.
3. Under Ind. Code § 25-26-17-6, a nonresident pharmacy must comply with laws where it is domiciled.

ORDER

Based on the foregoing Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law, the Board will register Steven's as a nonresident pharmacy and place that registration on **PROBATION**. Steven's may apply to have the probation withdrawn from its registration when its license in California is unencumbered.

The **TERMS AND CONDITIONS** of Probation are as follows:

- a) Steven's must keep the Board apprised in writing of its current address, mailing address, e-mail address, and telephone number.
- b) Steven's must abide with the terms and conditions of its probation in California.
- c) Steven's must immediately notify the Indiana Board of any change in the above terms and conditions or any violations of those terms and conditions within ten days after they occur.

d) Steven's must immediately notify the Indiana Board of any changes in status and/or discipline regarding any license, permit, or registration in any other jurisdiction where it does business.

e) Steven's shall not violate any laws regulating a nonresident pharmacy in Indiana.

The failure of Steven's to comply with the terms of this decision may subject it to a show cause hearing and the imposition of further sanctions.
