PETITION FOR SUMMARY SUSPENSION

The State of Indiana ("Petitioner"), by Counsel, Office of the Indiana Attorney General, by Deputy Attorney General Darren R. Covington, moves the Indiana Board of Pharmacy ("Board") to summarily suspend the pharmacist license of John T. Webb, R.Ph. ("Respondent") for ninety (90) days and in support of its petition states the following:

1. This Board has jurisdiction to suspend Respondent's license in accordance with the provisions of Ind. Code ch. 4-21.5-4 and Ind. Code § 25-1-9-10.
2. Respondent's address on file with the Indiana Professional Licensing Agency is 3102 N. Warren Road, Bloomfield, Indiana 47424.
3. Respondent is a licensed pharmacist in the State of Indiana having been issued license number 26012306A on November 15, 1968.
4. On or around November 13, 2012, Respondent was charged in Vigo County, Indiana Superior Court with two counts of Dealing in a Controlled Substance, a Class B Felony; two counts of Obtaining a Controlled Substance by Fraud or Deceit, a Class D Felony; and, five counts of Theft, a Class D Felony, under Cause Number 84D01-1211-FB-03519.

5. These charges were based upon Respondent's diversion of controlled substances and cash from JR Pharmacy in Terre Haute, Indiana.

6. Due to the above facts, Respondent represents a clear and immediate danger to the public health and safety if allowed to continue to practice as a pharmacist in Indiana.

WHEREFORE, the State of Indiana requests that this Board set a hearing on this Petition for Summary Suspension and suspend Respondent's license for a period of ninety (90) days and for all other proper relief.

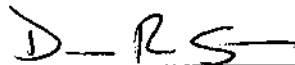
