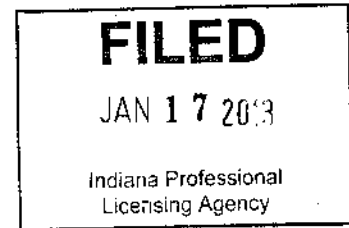

COMPLAINT

This complaint is brought against the pharmacist license of John T. Webb, R.Ph. (Respondent), by the Office of the Attorney General, by counsel, Deputy Attorney General Darren R. Covington, on behalf of the State of Indiana (Petitioner) and pursuant to Ind. Code § 25-1-7-7, Ind. Code § 25-1-5-3, Ind. Code ch. 25-26-13, the Administrative Orders and Procedures Act, Ind. Code art. 4-21.5 and Ind. Code ch. 25-1-9 and in support alleges and states:

FACTS

1. Respondent's address on file with the Indiana Professional Licensing Agency is 3102 N. Warren Road, Bloomfield, Indiana 47424.
2. Respondent is a licensed pharmacist in the State of Indiana having been issued license number 26012306A on November 15, 1968.
3. On or around November 13, 2012, Respondent was charged in Vigo County, Indiana Superior Court with two counts of Dealing in a Controlled Substance, a Class B Felony; two counts of Obtaining a Controlled Substance by Fraud or Deceit, a Class D Felony; and, five counts of Theft, a Class D Felony, under Cause Number 84D01-1211-FB-03519.
4. These charges were based upon Respondent's diversion of controlled substances and cash from JR Pharmacy in Terre Haute, Indiana.

5. On or around December 10, 2012, the Indiana Board of Pharmacy summarily suspended Respondent's license for ninety days.

COUNT I

6. Paragraphs 1 through 5 are incorporated by reference herein.

7. Respondent violated Ind. Code § 25-1-9-4(a)(8)(A) in that Respondent has diverted a legend drug as evidenced by her unauthorized taking of controlled substances from JR Pharmacy.

WHEREFORE, Petitioner demands an order against the Respondent that:

1. Imposes the appropriate disciplinary sanction;
2. Directs Respondent to immediately pay all costs incurred in the prosecution of this case; and,
3. Provides any further relief as the Board deems just and proper.
