SUMMARY SUSPENSION ORDER

An administrative hearing was held on December 10, 2012, before the Indiana Board of Pharmacy ("Board") in Room W064 of the Indiana Government Center South, 402 West Washington Street, Indianapolis, Indiana 46204, to consider the Petition for Summary Suspension ("Petition") filed against John T. Webb, R.Ph. ("Respondent") by the State of Indiana ("Petitioner") on December 4, 2012.

The State of Indiana was represented by Darren R. Covington, Deputy Attorney General. Respondent failed to appear in person or by counsel.

The Board, pursuant to Ind. Code § 4-21.5-4-1 *et seq.* and Ind. Code § 25-1-9-10, by a vote of 6-0-0, **SUMMARILY SUSPENDS** the license held by Respondent for ninety (90) days as the Board finds that an emergency exists and that Respondent represents a clear and immediate danger to the public health and safety if allowed to practice pharmacy in the State of Indiana.

This **NON-FINAL** emergency order is based on evidence supporting the following findings:

1. This Board has jurisdiction to suspend Respondent's license in accordance with the provisions of Ind. Code ch. 4-21.5-4 and Ind. Code § 25-1-9-10.

2. Respondent's address on file with the Indiana Professional Licensing Agency is 3102 N. Warren Road, Bloomfield, Indiana 47424.

3. Respondent is a licensed pharmacist in the State of Indiana having been issued license number 26012306A on November 15, 1968.

4. On or around November 13, 2012, Respondent was charged in Vigo County, Indiana Superior Court with two counts of Dealing in a Controlled Substance, a Class B Felony; two counts of Obtaining a Controlled Substance by Fraud or Deceit, a Class D Felony; and, five counts of Theft, a Class D Felony, under Cause Number 84D01-1211-FB-03519.

5. These charges were based upon Respondent's diversion of controlled substances and cash from JR Pharmacy in Terre Haute, Indiana.

WHEREFORE, RESPONDENT IS ORDERED to immediately cease all acts constituting the practice of pharmacy for a period of ninety (90) days, effective December 10, 2012.

ORDERED, this 14 day of December, 2012; this Summary Suspension Order is effective as of December 10, 2012.
