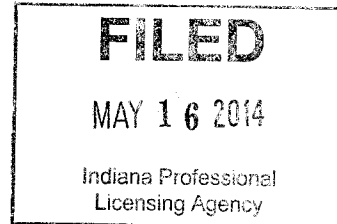

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FINDINGS OF FACT, CONCLUSIONS OF LAW AND ORDER

The Indiana State Board of Pharmacy ("Board") held an administrative hearing on May 12, 2014, in Room W064 of the Indiana Government Center South, 402 West Washington Street, Indianapolis, Indiana, concerning Bradley Ypma's ("Ypma") request to reinstate his license.

The State of Indiana was represented by Amanda Elizondo Deputy Attorney General. Ypma appeared in person and waived his right to be represented by counsel.

The Board, after considering the evidence presented and taking official notice of its file in this matter, voted 6 to 0 to issue the following Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Order:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Ypma, who resides at 2089 West Van Arsall Court, Columbus, Indiana 47201, is a duly registered pharmacist in the State of Indiana holding license number 26022716A.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. "The board may reinstate a license which has been suspended under this chapter if, after a hearing, the board is satisfied that the applicant is able to practice with reasonable skill and safety to the public. As a condition of reinstatement, the board may impose disciplinary or corrective measures authorized under this chapter." Ind. Code § 25-1-9-11.
2. Because Ypma has established that he may practice with reasonable skill and safety to the public if he complies with the terms of his probation, he qualifies for reinstatement of his license on probation.

ORDER

Based upon the above Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law the Board issues the following Order:

Ypma's license shall be placed on **INDEFINITE PROBATION**. Ypma may not seek withdrawal of the probationary status of his license until three years from the date of this order.

1. During the Probationary Period, Ypma's pharmacist's license shall be governed by the following **TERMS AND CONDITIONS**:
 - a. Ypma shall keep the Board apprised of his current residence, mailing address, e-mail address and residential telephone number at all times;
 - b. Ypma shall keep the Board apprised of his place of employment, employment telephone number and name of his supervisor at all times.

- j. Ypma shall not be a qualifying pharmacist while he is on probation.
 - k. Ypma shall continue going to his counselor at least two times a month until the counselor informs the Board in writing that he no longer needs to attend counseling that frequently or he is discharged from counseling.
 - l. Ypma shall make probationary appearances before the Board at the normally scheduled monthly board meetings monthly for the first year he is on probation and quarterly thereafter. His first appearance will be on June 9, 2014.
 - m. Ypma shall maintain and comply with his monitoring contract with the PRN for the entire period of time he is on probation and attend 12 Step meetings as PRN directs.
 - n. Ypma shall comply with all state and federal laws regulating the practice of pharmacy or operation of a pharmacy.
 - o. Ypma shall not work more than 10 hours a day, or 45 hours a week.
 - p. Ypma shall perform two hours of community service a month and document his having done so during his personal appearances.
2. It is further Ordered that:
- a. Any information received by any other regulatory agency that indicates non-compliance with the statutes or regulations regarding the competent practice of pharmacy;
 - b. a positive urine drug screen; or
 - c. a violation of the Final Order,

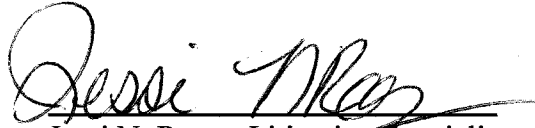
