ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE

Comes now the State Board of Registration for Land Surveyors (“Board”), on its own motion and pursuant to Ind. Code § 4-21.5, and hereby **ORDERS** Respondent William E. Pettit to appear before the Board on July 9, 2010, at 10:00 a.m., in Conference Center Room 5, Indiana Government Center South, 402 W. Washington Street, Indianapolis, Indiana 46204.

Respondent is to show cause why further disciplinary action should not be imposed against Respondent’s registration to practice land surveying in the State of Indiana, license number LS80900006, due to apparent noncompliance with the probationary terms as set forth in the Board’s Order of April 30, 2009, in that, the Respondent has failed to comply with the terms and conditions as follows:

- a. Respondent must submit to the Board monthly land surveying logs, or a statement that Respondent has not performed any surveys, if he has not, by the third (3rd) day of each month. Logs must contain the following information:
 - i. List of surveys performed the previous month;
 - ii. Date of the surveys;
 - iii. Type of surveys;
 - iv. Address of property; and
 - v. Client name.
- b. In addition to the above mentioned logs, Respondent must submit a copy of all surveys and related documentation, including, but not limited to, field notes and deeds.


The Respondent has not complied with the terms and conditions of the Order by failing to improve in the quality of his surveys which have been submitted to the Board. A copy of the Final Order, which placed Respondent's license on probation, filed April 30, 2009, is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference as Exhibit A.

8. A party who fails to attend or participate in a pre-hearing conference, hearing, or other later stage of this proceeding may be held in default or have the proceeding dismissed under section Ind. Code § 4-21.5-3-24.
