




In addition to the dozens of artist studios in Nashville and the surrounding countryside, you'll find inspiring public art collections at the Nashville Town Hall, Brown County Courthouse, Brown County Public Library, Brown County Office Building, Artists Colony Inn, Hobnob and Nashville House.

Destinations in and Around Nashville

While you and your family are visiting Brown County, be sure to visit the T.C. Steele State Historic Site where you can tour the famous impressionistic painter's Large Studio and House of the Singing Winds. You'll also want to tour the Pioneer Village in downtown Nashville and Bill Monroe's Music Park and Campground located in nearby Bean Blossom.
