OCTOBER 4, 2022

CALL TO ORDER/NOTING OF QUORUM

Chairman Allen called the meeting to order and noted the quorum and the attendance. Vice Chairman Payne, Commissioner Maginn, Commissioner Grubb, Deputy Director Kirkman, General Counsel Merritt, and Prosecutor Wignall were present.

DISPOSITION OF MINUTES

Vice Chairman Payne moved to approve the minutes from the September 20, 2022 meeting. Commissioner Grubb seconded. The motion was unanimously approved.

PROSECUTOR'S RECOMMENDATIONS

<u>PARTIES' AGREED DISPOSITIONS</u> – Vice Chairman Payne moved to approve the Parties' Agreed Dispositions, submitted by Prosecutor Wignall. Fifty-five dispositions were submitted with fines totaling \$27,250.00. Commissioner Grubb seconded. The motion was unanimously approved.

HEARING JUDGE'S RECOMMENDATIONS

<u>RR45-03852 MTM SERVICES, INC.</u> – Vice Chairman Payne, who sat as hearing judge, stated this permittee received a violation for serving after hours. The permittee appealed the Prosecutor's settlement offer and an appeal hearing was held.

Vice Chairman Payne moved to find the permittee in violation and assess a \$1,000.00 fine. Commissioner Maginn seconded. The motion was unanimously approved.
