



Indiana Auditor of State Tera Klutz, CPA

Focused on providing accurate information, maintaining and enhancing government transparency, and delivering great customer service to Hoosiers

Tera K. Klutz is the 57th Indiana Auditor of State and the first Certified Public Accountant to serve as the state's Chief Financial Officer. Appointed by Governor Eric J. Holcomb in January 2017 and elected to a four-year term in November 2018, Klutz is focused on providing accurate information, maintaining and enhancing government transparency, and delivering great customer service to ALL Hoosiers.

Prior to becoming the Auditor of State, Klutz served as the County Auditor in Allen County, Indiana, the state's largest county, geographically, and the third largest by population. First elected in 2010 and again in 2014, Klutz streamlined the local government processes, reduced debt, and maintained a balanced budget with responsible reserves. Between 2013 and 2016, Klutz was very active in the Association of Indiana Counties' Legislative Committee. As Chairwoman, she oversaw and directed the Association's legislative priorities by assisting in the analysis and review of proposed legislation and regularly testified before committees of the Indiana General Assembly.

In 2016, Klutz was named the Indiana Auditor of the Year by the Indiana Auditors' Association for her dedicated and tireless work. Before serving in the public sector, Klutz served as a Senior Accountant at both Crowe and PriceWaterhouseCoopers in Ft. Wayne, Indiana.

During her second year as State Auditor, Klutz released an update to the Indiana Transparency Portal which uses the latest in data delivery technology to provide a more accessible and in-depth look at Indiana's finances and assets. The updated portal offers information through interactive dashboards that give users an easy-to-understand snapshot of the data, while still offering the raw data in searchable fields. Updates to the Portal will continue into 2019.

Auditor Klutz has also created an Internal Controls Department to review and document the processes within the office in order to reduce the risk of misstatement or opportunities for fraud within the state's financial system.

Klutz holds a Bachelor's Degree in Accounting from Indiana University- Purdue University Ft Wayne. She is married to Zach and they have 2 daughters; Alyx and Julian and a Goldendoodle named Margo. Auditor Klutz is a member of the Indiana CPA Society, the American Institute of CPAs, Pass the Torch, and Cornerstone Lutheran Church.
