BMV Warns Public of Updated Text Message Scam Now Referencing "BMV"

INDIANA – June 25, 2025— The Indiana Bureau of Motor Vehicles (BMV) has been made aware of a recent update to an ongoing text message scam targeting Hoosiers. Previously, fraudulent messages referred to the "DMV"; however, scammers have now altered the content to specifically reference the "BMV" in an effort to appear more legitimate to Indiana residents.

We want to make it clear that these messages are not from the Indiana BMV.

The BMV does not send SMS text messages about outstanding penalties. Any such message should be considered fraudulent.

We urge the public to:

- Ignore these messages
- Do not click on any links
- Delete the message immediately
