<sup>2</sup> The BMV anticipates filing the proposed rule within 30 days of receiving approval of fiscal analyses from the State Budget Agency.

<sup>3</sup> The BMV anticipates conducting any public hearing within 60 days of posting of the proposed rule in the Indiana Register.

<sup>4</sup> The attorney general has 45 days from the date that an agency submits or resubmits a rule pursuant to Ind. Code § 4-22-2-32.

<sup>5</sup> The governor has 15 days from the date of rule submittal to approve or disapprove the rule. However, the governor may take 30 days to approve or disapprove the rule if the governor files a statement with the publisher within the first 15 days after rule submittal that states the governor intends to take an additional 15 days to approve or disapprove the rule pursuant to Ind. Code § 4-22-2-34.

<sup>6</sup> Rule becomes effective 30 days after filing with the Publisher (unless a later effective date is specified in the rule) pursuant to Ind. Code § 4-22-2-36.
