Staff recommendation

The commission staff recommends that Art Institute of Indianapolis be granted the authority to award the Associate of Science degree in the following program:

The Art Institute of Indianapolis: AS Baking and Pastry

Background

The Art Institute of Indianapolis is nationally accredited by the Accrediting Council for Independent Colleges and Schools (ACICS).

The Associate of Science program consists of 111 quarter hours of training, and a minimum of 50% of the courses are in the specialty. The Baking and Pastry program as submitted is closely matched in specialty versus general education/liberal arts as current programs approved and offered at The Art Institute of Indianapolis.

More than half the faculty members hold a Master's degree. Of the remaining 3 faculty members, one holds a Bachelor of Science degree in Dietetics. Another faculty member holds an Associate of Occupational Science Culinary Arts Degree, and 9 years of experience. The remaining faculty member has obtained an Associate of Applied Science Culinary Arts degree, with 7 years experience. 570 IAC 1-10.1-4 states that faculty members not holding a Bachelor of Science degree or higher "may be evaluated in comparison with similar institutions or programs in the public or private sector of postsecondary education."

The Associate of Science in Baking and Pastry program is designed to serve the food service industry career focused student, as well as the career changers. Graduates will use the degree to advance their careers in their current field, transition to a career with greater baking and pastry responsibility, or pursue a management position.

This program will provide students with culinary skills combined with a focus on baking and pastry. This combination skill set and business knowledge will enhance each graduate's ability to meet the challenges of an increasingly demanding and rapidly changing field. Two strengths of the program of study are an emphasis on culinary skills, as well as the core baking and pastry courses and the business courses.

The program's assessment plan is exemplary. It presents program goals and objectives, student learning outcomes, and assessment strategies. Ongoing evaluation of program vitality will include end-of-program student assessment, alumni, and employer satisfaction surveys, and internal and external program reviews. Student employment and graduate placement will help gauge the program's success in preparing students for work and/or advanced studies.
