

The Vanderburgh County Public Defender Agency in Evansville, Indiana has openings for

**Applicants must be licensed to practice law in Indiana.** Prior experience in criminal law is preferred but not required. This is an excellent opportunity for an attorney who has a desire to develop trial and negotiation skills in a fast-paced courtroom setting. The Public Defender office has a staff of full-time and part-time attorneys with many years of experience, which allows for mentorship and collaboration.

The 2025 salary for full-time attorneys is \$79,393 (after the six-month probationary period) and the salary offers increases based on years of experience. The 2025 salary for part-time attorneys is \$47,000. The compensation also includes a generous benefits package, including an excellent insurance plan, PERF contributions, and the ability to participate in the federal student loan forgiveness program.
