Current Population

Current POP. Population estimate by county.

Metrics taken yearly. Data as of 2016. U.S. Census Bureau, Annual Population Estimates.

Net Migration

Net Migration. The calculation of gross in-migration (people moving into an area) and gross out-migration (people moving out of that area). If net migration is positive, there are more people moving into an area than moving out.

Data as of 2017. U.S. Census Bureau, Annual Population Estimates.

Daily Net Commuting Patterns

Daily Net Comm Patterns. This indicator contains two metrics. The number of people living outside of the county and commuting into the county to work and the number of people living in the county and commuting outside of the county for work.

Metrics taken yearly. Data as of 2016. Indiana Department of Revenue IT-40 Tax Returns.

Median Average Age of Population

MED AVG Age of POP. 2010 data are Census counts. The other years are population estimates. True median ages could not be created for Economic Growth Regions. Therefore, all the medians were averaged over the geography. In reality, this is an average median age. Metrics taken yearly. Data as of 2017. U.S. Census Bureau, Annual Population Estimates.

PROJ Growth. Population projections, projected out to 2050 from the Indiana Business Research Center (IBRC).

Violent Crime(s). Number of reported violent crime offenses per 100,000 population.

Obesity Rate

Obesity RT. The percentage of adults that report a Body Mass Index (BMI) ≥ 30 .

Life Expectancy. Average life expectancy (in years) by county

Post-Secondary Educational Attainment

Post-SEC EDU Attainment. Attainment as the percentage of people ages 25-64 with at least an associate degree.

Dual Credit

Dual Credit. The percentage of 2016 high school graduates who earned credit hours awarded by Indiana public colleges recognized by both the high school and the postsecondary institution. Dual credit calculations only include credits awarded by Indiana public colleges.

Advanced Placement Utilization

AP Utilization. Percentage of 2017 high school graduates who took an AP exam during high school.

ISTEP 3rd Grade Reading. The percentage of students passing the reading section of the ISTEP+ in 3rd grade in school year 2017-18.

Kindergarten Retention

Kindergarten Return RT. The percent was calculated by taking the count of kindergarteners retained in the 2016-17 school year divided by the kindergartners enrolled in the 2015-16 school year (student's original cohort year). Some counties report over 100% of 5-year-olds enrolled in kindergarten, so their percents were adjusted to show 100%.

MED HH Income. Single-year estimate of median household income by county.

Metrics taken yearly. Data as of 2017. U.S. Census Bureau, Small Area Income and Poverty Estimates.

Average Hourly Wage

AVG HR Wage. Average hourly wage for workers.

Metrics taken quarterly. Data from the 2018. Bureau of Labor Statistics, Quarterly Census of Employment and Wages.

Entry Level Wage

Entry LVL Wage. Average wage for entry level workers.

Metrics taken yearly. Data as of 2017. Indiana Department of Workforce Development, Occupational Employment Statistics.

Per Capita Gross Domestic Product

Per Capita GDP. Gross Domestic Product accounting for the population. The Indiana Business Research Center estimates per capita GDP for Indiana counties.

Metrics taken yearly. Data as of 2016. Indiana Business Research Center (IBRC).

Unemployment Rate

Unemployment RT. The unemployment rate represents the number unemployed as a percent of the labor force. Data is not seasonally-adjusted at the county level.

Metrics taken yearly. Data as of 2017. Bureau of Labor Statistics, Local Area Unemployment Statistics.

Labor Force Participation

Labor Force Participation. The number of people in the labor force as a percentage of the civilian non-institutional population 16 years old and over.

Metrics taken yearly. Data as of 2017. Bureau of Labor Statistics, Local Area Unemployment Statistics.

Total Employment

TOT EMPLOY. Total number of workers in a county as reported derived from quarterly contribution reports filed by almost every employer in the U.S. It counts only filled jobs, whether full or part-time, temporary or permanent, by place of work.

Metrics taken quarterly. Data as of 2017. Bureau of Labor Statistics, Quarterly Census of Employment and Wages.

Total Labor Force

TOT Labor Force. The number of people who are either working or actively seeking work. Data is not seasonally-adjusted at the county level.

Metrics taken yearly. Data as of 2017. Bureau of Labor Statistics, Local Area Unemployment Statistics.

Industries of the top employers by county.

Households above ALICE Threshold

HH ABV ALICE Threshold. Number of households above the ALICE Threshold. The ALICE Threshold estimates the minimum income level necessary based on the total cost of household essentials – housing, child care, food, transportation, technology, and health care, plus taxes and a 10 percent contingency. Households below the Threshold include both ALICE households and those living in poverty.

Metrics taken bi-yearly. Data as of 2016. United Way ALICE, U.S. Census Bureau, American Community Survey 5-year estimates.

Total Corrections Released

TOT Corrections Released. Number of incarcerated individuals released by DOC to probation, community transition program (CTP), parole, or discharge during 2018. The county value used is the county of release for those released to probation or CTP, and the county where the most serious offense was committed for other types of release.

Metrics taken yearly. Data as of 2018. Indiana Department of Corrections.

Parolee Employment Percent

Parolee Empl%. Number of individuals on parole and employed divided by the total number of individuals on parole that are eligible to work, as of the last day of 2018. The county value used is the projected release county, or the county where the individual was committed to DOC custody if that is unavailable.

Metrics taken yearly. Data as of 2018. Indiana Department of Corrections.

Gateway to Work Non-Exempt Member Count

GTW MBR CNT. HIP Members required to participate in Gateway to Work, not exempt.

Metrics taken monthly.

Disability RT. The percentage of people living with a disability by county.
