

CTE Changes to Course Titles and Descriptions for 2022 – 2023

- Includes all new Next Level Programs of Study (NLPS) courses, including capstone courses and courses for the remaining pathways that were not revised for the 2021-2022 school year.
- Organized into two sections:
 - The first section includes ⁱNLPS courses and Perkins IV (Previously Existing) courses that are expected to be maintained through the transition to NLPS.
 - The second section includes the remaining "Perkins IV (Previously Existing) courses that will be phased out over the next two school years.
- Updated course code structure for all NLPS courses.
 - New NLPS course codes are listed in bold print.
 - Previous course codes are listed in parentheses.
 - New NLPS course codes will go into effect for the 2022-2023 school year.
- iiiReduction of most Perkins IV Level I courses from a maximum of 3 credits per semester to a maximum of 1 credit per semester.

ⁱ Introductory courses and any Perkins IV courses that are now included in the NLPS course section.
