


Asian Students

High School Pipeline and College Preparation

- 2% of high school graduates are Asian
- The percentage of Asian high school graduates has grown 1 percentage point in the last 10 years
- 40% of Asian high school graduates come from a low-income household
- 71% of Asian high schoolers earn AP or dual credit
- 58% of Asian high school graduates earned an Academic Honors diploma


College Going Rates by Gender



College Access

- 75% of Asian high school graduates go straight to college. The statewide average is 61%


College-Going Rates by Socioeconomic Status



Early Success in College


- 64% of Asian students meet all three early college success metrics (no remediation; complete all attempted credits; persist to second year)

Asian Students (continued)


Asian Students' On-Time Two-Year Institution Completion



On-Time Completion

- 12% of Asian Hoosiers graduate from two-year campuses on time
- 58% of Asian Hoosiers graduate from four-year campuses on time


Asian Students' On-Time Four-Year Institution Completion



Extended-Time Completion

- 77% of Asian Hoosiers graduate from college within 6 years

Dual Credit and Completion

- Students who earned AP or dual credit in high school were more likely to graduate college on-time and to graduate at all
