### **PROGRAM OVERVIEW:** TUITION AND FEE EXEMPTIONS (CVO) AND NATIONAL GUARD SUPPLEMENTAL GRANT

## NATIONAL GUARD SUPPLEMENTAL GRANT (NGSG)

### **PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS**

- Indiana National Guard Requirements
  - Must be a member of the Indiana National Guard in active drilling status
- Must be a high school graduate or equivalent
- Must file the current year FAFSA with an eligible Indiana institution listed
- College or Vincennes University)
- Students have 6 years (12 semesters) of state aid eligibility
- Must maintain Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP)
- Assistance (TA) from the U.S. Army

Must not have been AWOL at any time during the 12 months prior to their enrollment in college for any academic term Must have all required ING paperwork submitted and approved to their ING education office prior to the start of classes

Must be seeking an associate, first bachelor's or master's degree (or a Title IV-eligible certificate at Ivy Tech Community

Must have filed an application for and, if applicable, used any federal and state financial assistance available, including Tuition







## NATIONAL GUARD SUPPLEMENTAL GRANT (NGSG)

- Up to 100% tuition and regularly assessed fees at Indiana public colleges and universities.
- Students must apply in ScholarTrack and file the FAFSA annually. There is no FAFSA deadline.
- The National Guard reviews and enters a decision for all submitted NGSG applications each term.
- The 2022-2023 National Guard Supplemental Grant (NGSG) application launched in ScholarTrack on June 15, 2022.

## **SCHOLARSHIP OVERVIEW**

- Provides 200 scholarships each year to high-achieving high school and college students
- Grants up to \$7,500 per year for four years
- Requires that recipients teach at an eligible Indiana school for five consecutive years upon graduation



Up to \$30,000 in teaching scholarships are available through the Next Generation Teacher Scholarship.

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## SCHOLARSHIP OVERVIEW

- 2022-23 recipients will make up the 6<sup>th</sup> cohort.
- Inaugural cohort (2017-18) progress:
  - 83.5% licensed teachers (167)
  - 5% pursuing additional education (10)
  - 11.5% no longer pursuing education/receiving the award (23)
- More than 210 recipients from all cohorts are currently teaching.





## YEAR 6 APPLICANTS (2022-23)

 In total, 626 applications were submitted. This represents a 43% increase in applications compared to last year when there were 437 submitted.

### **Grade Level**

- → 75% High School Seniors (470)
- → 25% College Students (156)

## **Race/Ethnicity**

- → 89% White Students (559)
- $\rightarrow$  11% Students of Color (67)\*

\*Represents 50% increase in applications submitted by Students of Color year-overyear







## HOW TO BECOME A TRAINING PROVIDER

- Workforce Ready Grant programs and training providers are considered based on employer demand, wages, job placements and program completion rates.
- All approved industries, programs and training providers are reviewed regularly to ensure the Workforce Ready Grant is meeting the needs of Hoosiers and the State.
- There are two ways to apply (business/employer or institution)



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## HOW TO BECOME A TRAINING PROVIDER

- Institutions of higher education (offering either credit-bearing or non-credit-bearing programs) interested in becoming a training provider:
  - Review the 'Procedures for Postsecondary Institutions'
  - Complete and submit the Commission's program request form
    - Includes: Flame Rating, Sector, Credit Hours, Total Cost, Current and Projected Enrollment
- The Commission considers, processes and approves training provider applications processes and approves all applications twice a year, in alignment with the academic calendar.





## HOW TO BECOME A TRAINING PROVIDER

- Businesses interested in becoming a non-credit training provider:
  - Must be currently listed on the INTraining Eligible Training Provider List (ETPL)
  - Must apply through the Training Provider Portal
- The Indiana Department of Workforce Development (DWD) considers, processes and approves training provider applications monthly/as submitted.
