#### HISTORIC FUNDING INCREASE

- > \$252M in total increased General Fund support for higher education
  - FY25 ongoing support is \$136M above FY23
- \$630M in cash funded capital projects





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### INSTITUTIONS – OPERATING

- Operating support of 4% & 6%, or \$130M new money over the biennium
  - 50% base adjustment & 50% performance
  - Retained 2% & 3% base adjustment
  - Retained 1% & 1% legacy performance funding
  - Funds new performance formula at 1% & 2%
  - No prospective funds for IU/PU Indianapolis in either year



#### INSTITUTIONS – LINE ITEMS

- Support for Commission recommendation for dual credit and R&R
  - Combined \$13M/year increase
- One-time transition funding for both IU and PU at \$10M each
- Provided PU in Indy with \$17M base operating in FY25
- Provided IU Indy with operating adjustment totaling \$9.8M over biennium
- \$225K increase to PU for Ag Research and Extension
- ▶ \$1.3M increase to PU for Animal Disease Diagnostic Laboratory (IC 21-46-3)



#### INSTITUTIONS – LINE ITEMS

- Provided \$4.5M in one-time funding to VU for Avionics Training and Employment
- Provided \$9M/year to ITCC to fund nursing expansion
- Provided \$600K/year to USI for the Early College Bridge Program





### INSTITUTIONS — CAPITAL

- > \$476M for each institution's #1 capital priority per Commission recommendation
- \$60M to IU and \$60M to PU for Indianapolis capital investment
- > \$9.8M to IU & \$4.2M to PU for regional deferred maintenance (\$2.4M above FY23)
- > \$15M to PFW for the Rhinehart Music Center Addition
- > \$5M to PWL for the ADDL lab improvement
- All projects were cash funded in the current fiscal year (FY23) except for the FY25 cash funding of regional R&R



#### COMMISSION

- Maintained Governor's support for agency operating and financial aid
  - Workforce Ready Grant from \$1M to \$6M
  - EARN Indiana From \$600K to \$2.6M
- Increased support for K-12 teacher scholarship programs
  - Next Generation Hoosier Educator from \$6M to \$12M
  - Minority Student Teaching Stiped from \$50K to \$100K
  - \*NEW\* Next Generation Minority Educator Scholarship \$600K
- Consolidated several administrative funds and restored 2021 budget reductions



### COMMISSION

- Martin University \*New\*
  - \$2.5M/year to attract and retain students
- College Success Program \*New\*
  - \$2.5M/year for programs and capital investment at four-year institutions
- Heartland/Anderson Scholar House \*New\*
  - > \$2M one-time funding
