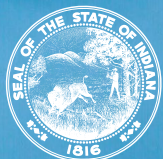
In post-high school training and education **going-rates** for youth and adults – Indiana currently ranks...

- **31st** in the college-going rate for youth (2020)
- **21st** in first-time undergraduate enrollment of adults (2020)



In **postsecondary attainment** for veterans, individuals with disabilities and the justice involved – Indiana currently ranks...

- **47th** in total educational attainment of veterans aged 25-64 (2021)
- **45th** in total educational attainment of those with a disability aged 25-64 (2021)
- **43rd** in the percentage of adults in correctional facilities enrolled in school or college (2021)

In **utilization of credit for prior learning** – Indiana currently is...

- **1 of 43** states to not have a comprehensive state-wide credit for prior learning policy (2020)

In measurable distinction of **social and economic mobility and prosperity** – Indiana currently ranks...

- **35th** on the Human Development Index (2021)
 - The values of three dimensions – education, health and standard of living.

In the rate at which Hoosiers successfully **complete their chosen areas of study** – Indiana currently ranks...

- **11th** in total six-year completion rates among first-time students enrolling in 2- or 4-year public and private institutions (2023)

As the **recognized state for growing or starting a business** based upon the strength of **human capital** – Indiana currently ranks...

40th in attainment among working-age adults with an associate degree or higher
+ 3rd in attainment among working-age adults with only a certificate or certification
= 22nd in total educational attainment beyond a high school diploma among working-age adults (2021)



In **retaining talent** once someone has graduated – Indiana currently ranks...

- **36th** in retention and migration of college graduates (2021)
