Together we have the privilege of leading efforts that will provide greater **Hoosier Opportunities and Possibilities through Education (HOPE)**. Those combined efforts will allow us to seize, leverage, and make manifest the potential for Indiana to become a **Top 10 State** by 2030:



In post-high school training and education **going-rates** for youth and adults – Indiana currently ranks...

- **33rd** in college-going rate for youth (2022)
- **13th** in undergraduate enrollment of adults compared to working-age population (2023)



In **postsecondary attainment** for veterans, individuals with disabilities and the justice-involved – Indiana currently ranks...

- **45th** in total educational attainment of veterans aged 25-64 (2023)
- **43rd** in total educational attainment of those with a disability aged 25-64 (2023)
- **44th** in percentage of adults in correctional facilities enrolled in school or college (2023)

In **utilization of credit for prior learning** – Indiana currently is...

- **1 of 8** states to have a comprehensive statewide credit for prior learning policy (2024)



In measurable distinction of **social and economic mobility and prosperity** – Indiana currently ranks...

- **40th** on the Human Development Index (2022)
 - The values of three dimensions – education, health and standard of living.



In the rate at which Hoosiers successfully **complete their chosen areas of study** – Indiana currently ranks...

- **9th** in total six-year completion rates among first-time students enrolling in 2- or 4-year public and private institutions (2024)



As the **recognized state for growing or starting a business** based upon the strength of **human capital** – Indiana currently ranks...

- **40th** in attainment among working-age adults with an associate degree or higher (2023)
- **40th** in attainment among working-age adults with a bachelor's degree or higher (2023)



In **retaining talent** once someone has graduated – Indiana currently ranks...

- **41st** in retention and migration of college graduates (2023)
