INDIANA COMMISSION FOR HIGHER EDUCATION

BUDGETUPDATE

AGENCY OPERATIONS

- Financial Aid Programs
 - House Budget maintained Governor's support for agency financial aid programs
 - *NEW* Public Service Attorney Scholarship \$1M each FY
- Agency Operating
 - House Budget maintained 5% operating reduction in Governor's Recommended Budget
- Transfer of Career Coaching Grant from IDOE to CHE



INSTITUTIONAL OPERATING

- House Budget supports FY25 earned as carry-forward into FY26 and FY27
 - ▶ While not funded this biennium, restoring the carryforward shows support for OBPF and the agency will still run OBPF goals vs. actuals to assess institutional performance
- R&R Appropriations added back in
 - 0.525% over Biennium; \$8.3M
- No new capital funding



INSTITUTIONAL OPERATING

- Dual Credit
 - House Budget incorporated CHE recommendation for proportional funding
 - ► House determined \$45 per credit hour; resulting in \$2.7M increase over biennium
- Other Line Items
 - *NEW* IU Innovates \$1M
 - > \$5M Animal Disease Diagnostic Lab (Purdue) transferred to Board of Animal Health
