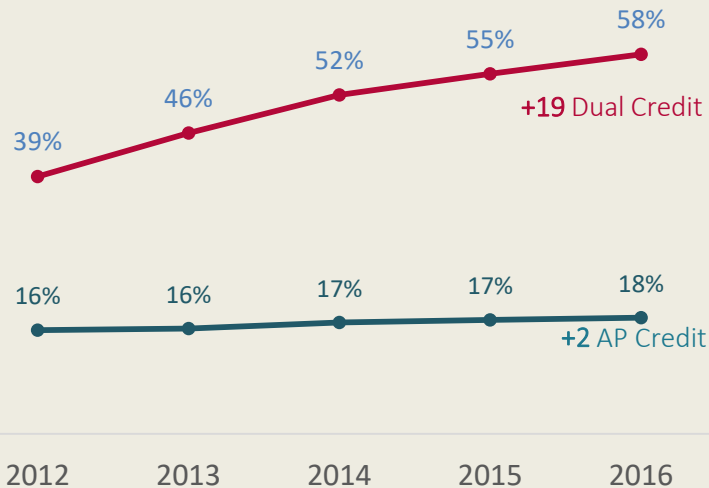

% HS Grads Earning AP or Dual Credit



62% of 2016 HS Graduates earned Dual Credit, AP, or both

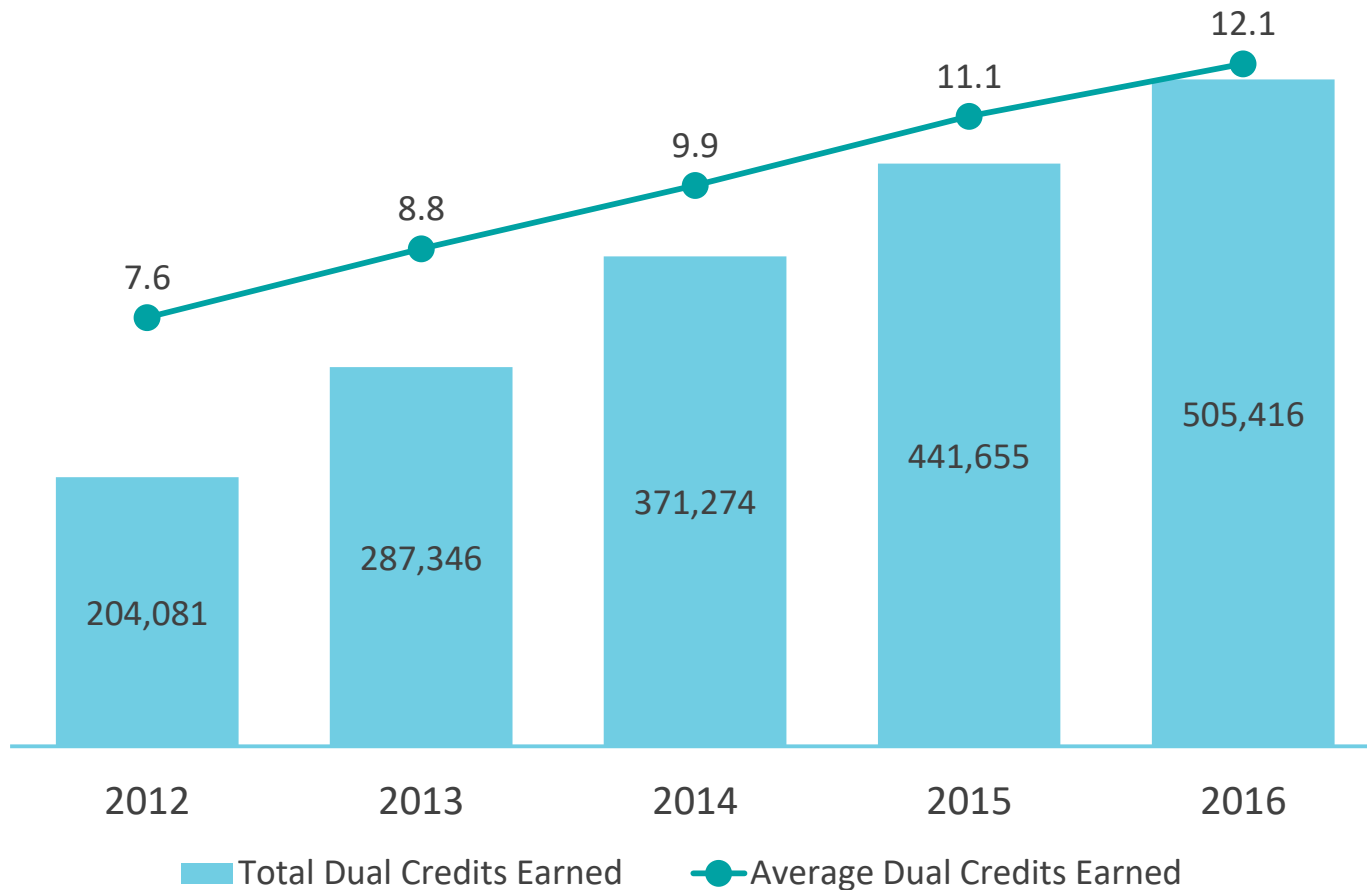
- In 2012, only 47% did

21st Century Scholars

- 71% of Scholars earn dual credit



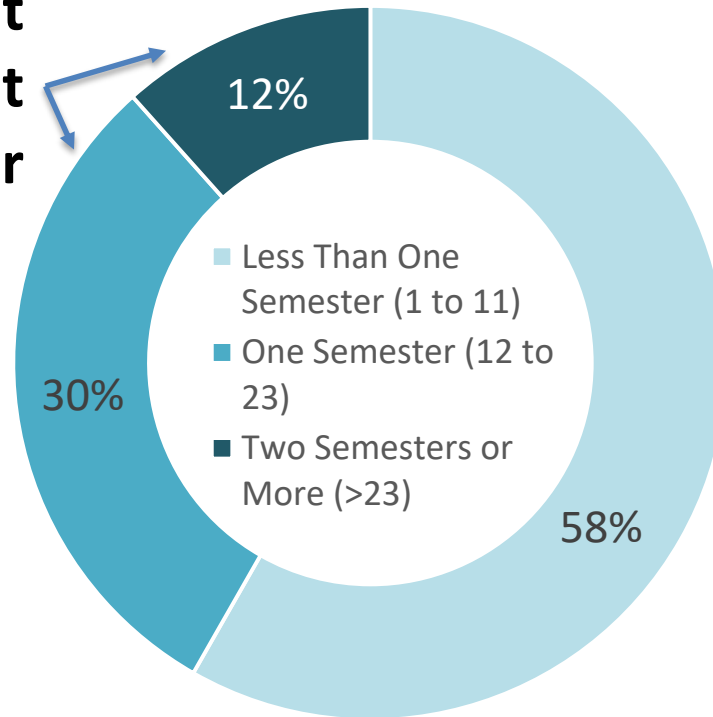
The Average DC Earner Graduates HS with Roughly a Semester of College Credit



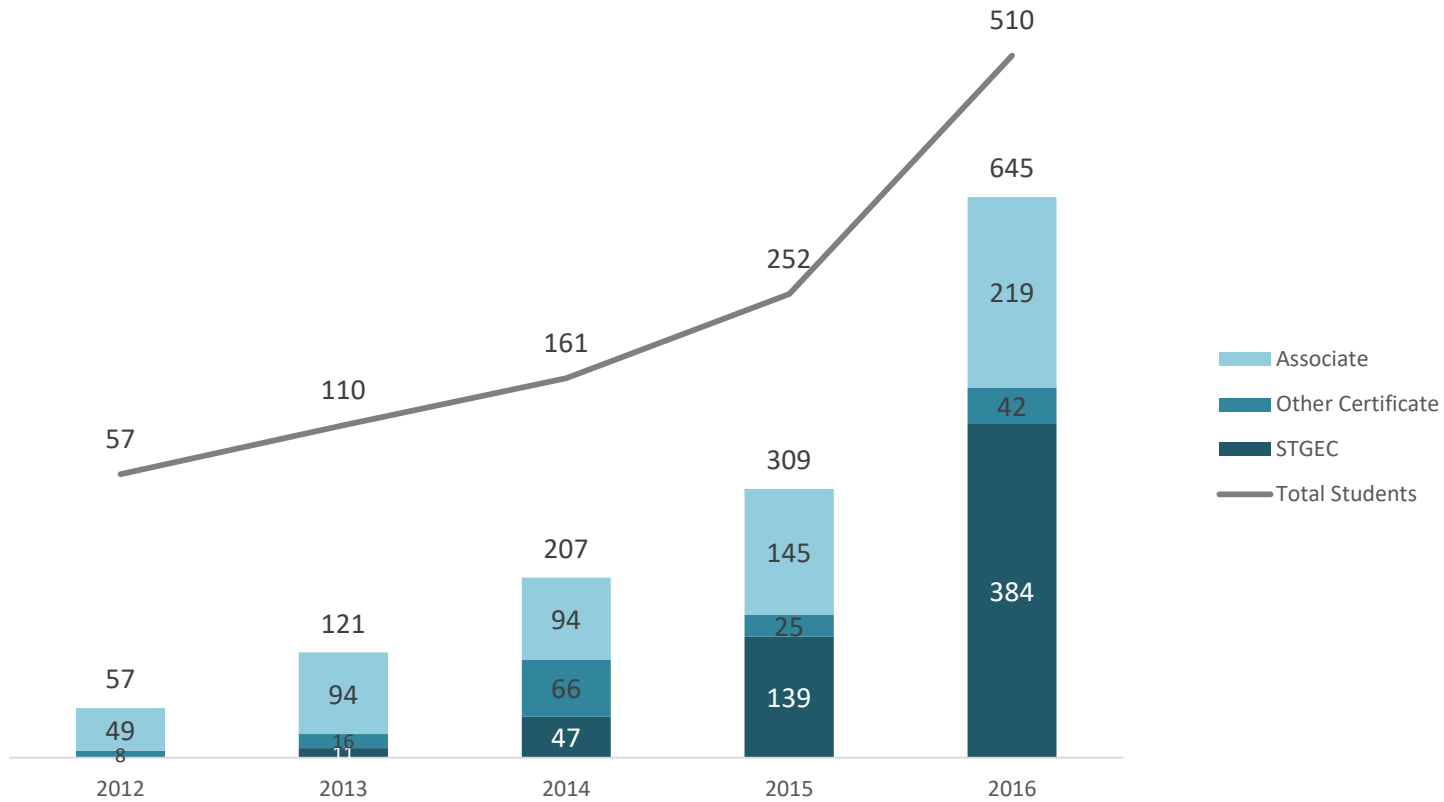
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The Average DC Earner Graduates HS with Roughly a Semester of College Credit

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Core Transfer Library (CTL)

- CTL created in 2005
- TransferIN website launched in 2008
- Statewide transferability of CTL courses guaranteed no matter what delivery mode:
 - Online
 - Dual Credit
- There are 88 CTL courses, of which 34 are Priority (Dual Credit) Liberal Arts courses

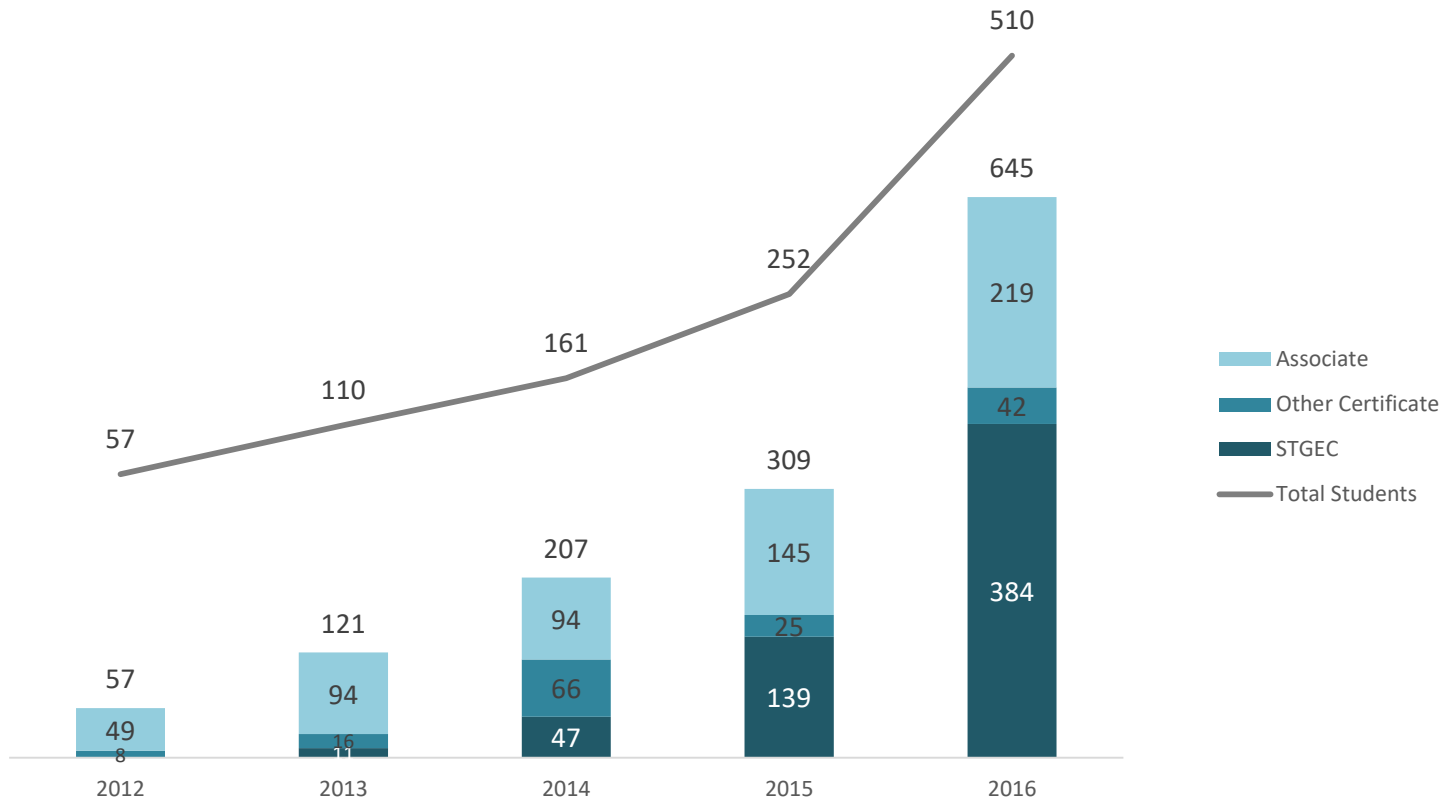

Programs Completed in FY2016

- Almost all of the associate degrees earned were in Liberal Arts or General Studies (217 out of 219)
- Certificates were earned in:
 - Phlebotomy Technician (12)
 - Welding Technology (12)
 - Other fields (18)



Career and Technical Education (CTE)

- The Commission and IDOE have developed a CTE crosswalk indicating how CTE courses taught for dual credit map into an Ivy Tech or VU certificate or associate degree program
- Only Priority Liberal Arts courses or courses on the CTE crosswalk are eligible to receive state dual credit funding





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
