# Identifying and Admitting At-Risk Students

- For admissions: previous practice was to conditionally admit those with a HS GPA between 2.2 and 2.5
- Current practice is more rigorous to assess motivation
- Once they've achieved good academic standing (ISU GPA of at least 2.0 ) they are no longer considered “conditionally admitted”



# Helping *All* Students Succeed

- Analytics, Alerts, and Proactive Advising
- Ongoing Monitoring
- Project Success program
- Case-management approach for Freshmen



# Academic Probation and Dismissal

- First-semester dismissals (.85 GPA)
- Key advising topic; academic assistance offered to those with poor interim grades
- Dismissed students advised to take courses at Ivy Tech



# Financial Literacy

- Greater transparency about full cost of attendance
- Dedicated staff member in Financial Aid
- Personal financial aid counseling at Orientation
- Cross-training and coordination with advisors
