CTE TRANSITION

- ▶ A deeper dive into Career and Technical Education (CTE) is planned for the November Meeting
- ▶ Eligible Agency –
 - ▶ A state board designated or created consistent with State law as the sole State agency responsible for the administration of Career and Technical Education in the State or for the supervision of the administration of CTE.
- ▶ To finalize CHE as the Eligible Agency for the US Department of Education, we need the Commission to formally approve the current CTE State Plan
 - ▶ The current CTE State Plan was submitted and approved prior to moving to the Commission

CARL D. PERKINS ACT

- ▶ The Perkins Grant provides just over \$32 million in Federal funding
 - ▶ 90% is distributed to eligible secondary and postsecondary recipients
 - ▶ 10% is used for grant administration and leadership
 - ▶ State funding for CTE enrollments this year is expected to exceed \$200 million
- ▶ State Plan was originally developed in 2020 as part of WIOA
 - ▶ Details how the grant will be utilized to meet requirements and performance targets
 - ▶ Sets the vision for CTE in the State
- ▶ 2023-24 represents the final year for the current plan



NEXT STEPS

- ▶ Opportunity to create a CTE Strategic Plan and a new Perkins State Plan
- ▶ Indiana is 1 of 4 states selected to receive support from Advance CTE
- ▶ Plan development process will include:
 - ▶ Self-Assessment
 - ▶ Stakeholder Engagement (Sept – December)
 - ▶ Data Analysis (November – January)
- ▶ The Academic Affairs & Quality Committee will receive updates on the process ahead of any voting by the Commission. We welcome your engagement if you are not on AA&Q.
