Summary of Recent Progress: The Data Sharing and Mapping Committee has completed gathering the substantive updates from the agencies for the anticipate ISG 2.0 update. This new version is adding Foster Parents as a separate record requestor as well as separating out mental health and addiction treatment records from general healthcare records.

In our Committee meeting, we showcased a data display regarding Medicaid outcomes for high school populations 1, 3, and 5 years post graduation/exit from high school. We presented this to Education Outcomes Task Force co-chairs to identify possible uses/next steps for the dashboard.

Discussed the CISC Strategic Priorities and came up with some recommendations to create quantitative, metric-based goals that we could aim for and track progress towards.
