### **1.1 Prevent child abuse and neglect**

Developed a list of prevention agencies (primary and secondary): service providers are unaware of each other. Surveyed 800 service providers and kinship care folks: 225 responses. List of statewide or large presence. Group agrees to get CISC endorsement to share this resource with 211.

Statewide Action Plan: Some strategic plans in place, but we need gap analysis, and identification of overlap, be able to access federal match dollars in 2019, better able to access CDC and other federal grants, improved data sharing
