The meeting was called to order by Mayor Siepman with all council members present.

Clerk Treasurer Landry held a public hearing for Additional Appropriations. There were no comments or questions. The hearing was closed and a motion to allow the Additional Appropriations Ordinance 2025-4 was made by Peggy Sluder with a second by Kathy May, all in favor.

A motion to approve the minutes was made by Peggy Sluder with a second by Brad Duncan, all in favor.

A motion to approve the claims was made by Kelly Portteus with a second by Brad Duncan, all in favor.

Clerk Treasurer Landry presented the council with a claim from HWC for the water treatment plant in the amount of \$12,415.00. A motion was made by Peggy Sluder to pay the claim with a second by Kelly Portteus all in favor.

Landry also presented the council with Graves pay application # 16 A in the amount of \$116,893.69. A motion was made to pay the claim by Peggy Sluder and a second by Kathy May, all in favor

Graves pay application # 16 B was presented for payment in the amount of \$79,111.65. A motion to pay the claim was made by Peggy Sluder with a second by Kent May, all in favor.

Graves pay application # 15 for the Water Treatment Plant in the amount of \$209,930.05 was presented for payment. A motion to pay the claim was made by Peggy Sluder with a second by Kathy May, all in favor.

Jon Query from HWC presented the council with a change order for the Shakamak Sewer Project in the amount of \$9,851.03. This change order is made to improve conditions for dumpsters pick up at the sewer plant. The motion to approve the change order was made by Peggy Sluder with a second by Brad Duncan, all in favor.

Police Report: 155 incidents were reported, some being 6 accidents, 1 battery, 5 juvenile complaints, 13 theft shoplifting, and 7 welfare checks.

Fire Report: 25 runs, 1 being fire. Duckworth reported that the fire department will be the host of the chili supper during homecoming this year, Duckworth also reported for the Park Board, the dugout on the third baseline at the city park diamond needs demolished.

Street Department reported they installed new door handle at the park community building. Installed new signs at the City Park. Repaired a yard on Oak St after a house fire, along with mowing and monthly duties.
