## **COMMON COUNCIL MEETING**

## **JANUARY 13, 2025**

The first meeting of the New Year 2025 was called to order by Mayor Siepman with all council members present. The minutes were read, and a motion was made by Peggy Sluder to accept the minutes as read with a second by Kent May all in favor.

A motion was made by Kelly Portteus to accept the claims with a second by Brad Duncan, all in favor.

The city had received two bids for the paving grant for 2025. The first bid opened by Mayor Siepman was E & B Paving at \$206,400.00. The second bid opened was from Milestone for \$207,501.23. A motion was made by Peggy Sluder to table the award of the bid until our paving engineer Chriss Jobe has to opportunity to review the bids. This motion was seconded by Brad Duncan, all in favor.

A claim for payment to HWC was presented for the water treatment plant in the amount of \$10,490.88. A motion to pay the claim to HWC in the amount of \$10,490.88 was made by Peggy Sluder with a second by Kathy May, all in favor. A claim was presented for HWC for the Shakamak State Park Project in the amount of \$16,073.75 a motion to pay this claim was made by Peggy Sluder with a second by Brad Duncan, all in favor.

It is the time of year to appoint a city representative to the SIDC Board historically the Mayor of the City has held this position. A motion was made by Kelly Portteus and seconded by Brad Duncan to nominate Mayor Siepman for this position. All in favor.

A motion was made by Kelly Portteus and seconded by Kent May to elect Brad Duncan as the Council President. All in favor!

Mayor Siepman gave a recap of 2024.

The police department reported 201 incidents some being, 6 property damage accident, 1 personal injury accident, 8 animal complaints, assisted the public 15 times, 2 domestic disputes and 45 walk-ins.

The fire department reported 316 runs for 2024 and 3 ems runs for this month.

Street Department reported moving a lot of snow, working on the new community building in the City Park, took down Christmas Lights, serviced all equipment, cleared snow from the sidewalks.

Mayor Siepman announced a new fund raiser for the Hanna Field Project, more information to come later.
