

CITY OF JASONVILLE
COMMON COUNCIL MEETING

JULY 14, 2025

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Siepman with all council members present.

The minutes were read and a motion to approve the minutes was made by Peggy Sluder with a second by Kelly Portteus, all in favor.

A motion was made to approve all claims by Kelly Portteus with a second by Brad Duncan, all in favor.

Clerk Treasurer Landry presented to the council with claims from HWC, the first claim was for \$1006.25 for the Shakamak Sewer Project. A motion to pay the claim was made by Peggy Sluder and a second by Kelly Portteus, all in favor. The second claim for HWC is for \$13356.84 for the Water Treatment Plant. A motion to pay the claim was made by Peggy Sluder with a second by Kent May, all in favor.

Landry also presented the council with pay application #4 from Graves Construction for the water treatment plant in the amount of \$208,412.30. A motion to pay the claim was made by Peggy Sluder with a second by Kathy May, all in favor.

Amended Salary Ordinance 2025-3 was presented for approval; this amendment changes the salary for Coda Keller who is in the water license apprenticeship program. He is to receive a \$.37 increase on the hour each 6 months. A motion to approve Ordinance 2025-3 was made by Peggy Sluder and seconded by Brad Duncan, all in favor.

Scott Aaron from the Alliance of Indiana Rural Water-AIRW was present at the meeting to present Jarred VanHorn with his Certificate of Completions of Apprenticeship. Congratulations Jarred on a job well done.

The Street Department reported repaired streetlights, repaired door at the ambulance building, helped pour cement at the city park building for handicap parking, installed flagpole and flag at city park, cleared trees from streets after storm, painted shop roof, and started Hanna Field Project.

Police reported 218 incidents, some being 6 accidents, 10 animal complaints, 1 burglary, 1 child neglect, 8 domestic disputes, 3 fights in progress, and 1 unruly person.

Fire Department reported 31 runs, 7 being fire and 24 EMS

Brad Duncan spoke for the Jasonville Chamber of Commerce thanking everyone involved during the fireworks. Great Show!! And next year it will be on July 3rd. Meeting adjourned
