COMMON COUNCIL

NOVEMBER 10, 2025

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Siepman, with all council members present.

With no additions or corrections to last month meeting minutes a motion to approve the minutes was made by Peggy Sluder with a second by Kathy May, all in favor.

A motion to approve the claims was made by Kelly Portteus with a second by Peggy Sluder, all in favor.

Clerk Treasurer Landry had a first reading of Ordinance # 2025-6, a motion to accept the first reading of Ordinance#2025-6 was made by Peggy Sluder with a second by Kelly Portteus, all in favor.

Landry presented the council with a claim from HWC in the amount of \$19,429.90. A motion to pay the claim was made by Peggy Sluder with a second by Kathy May. All in favor

Landry also presented a claim for the water treatment plant for Graves, pay application # 8 in the amount of \$389,179.85. A motion to pay the claims was made by Peggy Sluder with a second by Kent May, all in favor.

Two insurance quotes were presented to the council from Springer Insurance Co., and 1st Security Ins Co., These quotes are for liability insurance coverage for the city and utilities. A motion to table the decision to award the quote was made by Kathy May with a second by Brad Duncan, all in favor. A special meeting to discuss the insurance quotes has been scheduled for November 17th at 7pm.

Mayor Siepman gave an update on the progress at Hanna Field.

Jarred VanHorn gave a update on the progress at the water treatment plant.

Police Chief VanHorn reported 154 incidents, some being 4 accidents, 2 civil disputes, 5 domestic disputes, 1 fight in progress and 31 traffic stops. VanHorn reported that Halloween was a success.

Fire Chief Duckworth reported 18 runs 8 being fire.

Street Superintendent Strahla reported installing basketballs goals at Hanna Field, set the post for the pickleball nets, installed two new doors on the blue building at Hanna Field, winterized the bathrooms at city park and the reservoir, and repaired lights at the Senior Citizens Building.
