OCTOBER 14, 2025

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Siepman with all council members present.

There were no additions or corrections to the September meeting minutes, a motion was made by Peggy Sluder to approve the September minutes and a second by Kathy May, all in favor. A motion to approve the claims was made by Kelly Portteus with a second by Peggy Sluder, all in favor.

Clerk Treasurer Landry presented the 2026 Budget Ordinance # 2025-5, a motion to approve Ordinance # 2025-5 was made by Peggy Sluder with a second by Kathy May all in favor.

Landry presented Salary Ordinance # 2025-7 & 8 for the 2026 Salary Year, motion was made by Peggy Sluder to approve the Ordinance with a second by Brad Duncan, all in favor.

A pay request from HWC in the amount of \$21,761.35 was presented. A motion was made by Peggy Sluder and a second by Kent May to approve the request, all in favor

A pay request from Graves for the Water Treatment Plant pay application # 7 in the amount of \$773214.86 was presented for payment. A motion to pay the request was made by Brad Duncan with a second by Kent May, all in favor.

Graves pay application # 17 Division B for the Shakamak Sewer Project was presented for payment in the amount of \$20,000.00. A motion to pay the request was made by Peggy Sluder with a second by Kelly Portteus, all in favor. Graves pay application # 17 Division A was presented for payment in the amount of \$9851.03. A motion to pay the request was made by Kelly Portteus with a second by Peggy Sluder, all in favor.

Police report was given with 187 incidents, some being 29 traffic stops, 4 welfare checks, issued 2 citations, 3 juvenile complaints, 9 domestic disputes, 4 civil disputes and assisted other departments 12 times. Chief VanHorn announced the Trick or Treating for October 31, 2025, from 6-9pm

Fire report was 45 runs, 10 being fire and 35 ems

Street Department reported continued work at Hanna Field, repaired street sweeper, prepared for homecoming, repaired and winterized the splash pad, level dirt and filled in holes at the City Park, reset monkey bars at the City Park, and serviced the manlift.

Code Enforcement Officer reported back to work and made 17 stops about trash and mowing.
