WWTP - Hidrostal Pump #3 Repair Quote

Our third Hidrostal Pump went down. Indiana Pump Works provided a quote to do the repairs at a cost of 10,520. WWTP Superintendent Kenny Sprague stated we normally run two pumps but are only running one at this time since Pump #2 is in the process of being repaired and Pump #3 is not working. He asked the board to approve proceeding with the repair. It will take 10-12 weeks for the repair to be completed.

Park & Rec Dept. - Request to Hire for Rec Center PT/Fill in Employees

We have done the necessary background checks. Both are members of the Rec Center and familiar. Director John Parrish has done interviews with both, and Patti Nelson personally knows both. The minimum qualifications would include three years of experience in maintenance and one year as a team leader or supervisor. This would move the position to a higher grade eligible for a higher starting wage. Would like to offer the position internally for a lateral move first.
