- CCMG 2025-2 has been postponed; The CCMG 2026-1 application may open late this year.
- Veteran's Memorial: Contractor has site plan; project to be completed before July 4.
- Strawberry Valley Trail: Reviewing project scope and costs to rebid in 2025; likely construction in Spring 2026.
- INDOT Signal Project (SR 5): Delays due to pole supply; construction to be completed in 2025.
- Safe Streets for All Program: Proposed applying for a federal 80/20 planning grant (\$100,000 total; city share \$20,000) to develop a citywide safety action plan.
