New Business

1. Pay App. No. 1 – Kemp Construction for Pettit Park Pavilion Project

City Engineer Rick Pharis presented the first application and certification for payment on the project in the amount of \$44,475.30, stating all is in order to date.

2. County GIS Update for 2012

A request to help fund the update of the County GIS flyover was received from Steve Hook, GIS Coordinator for Noble County. The City is being asked to pay 2% of the cost, the same percentage as paid in 2008, for a 2012 total of \$800.00.

3. Write off request – bankruptcy

4. Request for two additional part-time Police Officers – Jason Koontz and Mike Houser

5. Fence at Street Dept.

A quote for an automatic gate opener and keypad for the new fence at the Street Dept. was presented. This will be a safety feature for the area containing the gas pumps. The cost would be split with the fire, police, and street departments. The cost for the automated opener is \$3430.00 and the keypad is \$560.00 for a total cost of \$3990.00.

6. Fence Issue – Mosley (Wicker) and Hursey

The ongoing issue of incorrect placement of a fence on West Third Street resulted in the City offering to move the fence to the correct position. However, Mr. Wicker is requesting the project be done on a Saturday when he is able to be home, as he has dogs. However, this would require overtime be paid to City employees. It was suggested to offer Mr. Wicker a set amount and pay him to move the fence on his own time. Further discussion resulted in the following motion:

Mayor Patty Fisel: The annual retention tank cleaning is taking place today at the water department.
