Street Micro Surfacing and Crack Sealing

A quote for crack sealing 14 streets was received from Pavement Solutions. They are the only company using fiber in the fill. They held at last year's price of .42/sy. The square yardage for the 14 streets is 63,265 for a total of \$26,571.30.

Pavement Solutions provided a quote for micro surfacing five alleys and Union Street from Townline to Smith. They also extended their 2016 prices for micro surfacing, \$2.90/sy for single course and \$4.00/sy for double course. The cost for single course on the alleys is \$8,903.00 and double course on Union Street is \$74,820.00, bring the total to \$83,723.00.
