Ed Rodriguez – La Voz Unida (Regarding Senate Bill 248)

Mr. Rodriquez from Plymouth, along with a large group of supporters from La Voz Unida, attended to ask the council to support Senate Bill 248 by passing a resolution to be forwarded to the state legislature. The bill would allow a Driving Record Card, which undocumented Indiana residents, after meeting certain criteria and passing a driving test, could obtain authorization to drive. They feel the bill would ensure that all drivers on Indiana roads are trained, insured, and identifiable by law enforcement. Currently 19 states allow undocumented residents to apply for a license or special certification to drive.
