Unfinished business:

New Business:

Alan informed the board that the Mayor has proposed a 2% wage increase across the board. Also concerning the budget, he would like to increase office supplies from \$1000 to \$2000 and Rec. supplies from \$200 to \$1000.

The city clerk notified Alan that sales tax will now be applied to park concessions and rentals.

Other Business:

The Rec. Center computer was down for over a week due to a storm.

Property lines at Pettit Park have been established. The cost of a new survey is \$300.

Gary advised the board that Alan had come in on a recent Sunday and repaired the splash pad and also there have been male citizens urinating in the park in the trees (the restrooms were open!).

T-ball and city league baseball games began on Monday, June 10th.
