The Winter Warm Up Sale had 61 vendors. A profit \$1195.00 was made by the park department to be used toward our youth programs and activities.

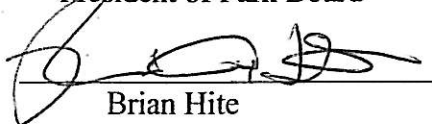
The 4 & 5 grade basketball tournament was held on February 8th. Sons of American Legion were the champions and Fashion Farm were the runners up.
