**Unfinished business:**

The board reviewed quotes from Hochstetlers (\$8,215.00) and Shrocks (\$12,400.00) to install sidewalks around and to the splash pad. \$8,000 in the splash pad fund can be used to help cover the cost. The board approved the quote of \$8,215.00 from Hochstetlers. Motion by Weimer, second by Byers. All ayes.

**New Business:**

The board discussed painting the surface of the splash pad. Alan received a quote from Ideal Coating for \$18,300.00. The work could be done by the park department using apoxy floor paint .

Resurfacing the Kenney Park main entrance drive up to the Rec. Center parking lot was discussed. \$6000 in CEDIT money and non-reverting construction money could be used.

Two ash trees will be taken down in the parks. Alan will talk to Jason Becker about possible new plantings in the fall.

Alan has talked with aerobics instructor Kelly Meeks about constructing an aerobics room on the north side of the Rec. Center. She will inform the aerobics class and see if the would like to help with fund raising.

**Other Business:**

Alan gave some background information on the Essex property. He will set up a time for the Park Board to meet with the Board of Works to discuss Pettit Park.

**Programs:**


The Youth Soccer League has 190 kids registered. There are 16 teams.

City League baseball & t-ball registration began on April 14.


The Ligonier travel leagues have begun practicing.
