The first summer session of aerobics has 30 participants.

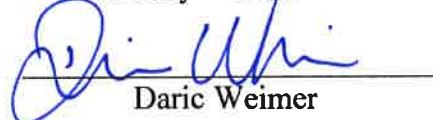
The meeting was adjourned at 5:45pm. Motion by Byers, second by Hagen. All ayes.
