The meeting was called to order by board president Brian Hite
The board approved the minutes for September. Motion by Byers, second by Kreager. All ayes.
The board approved the claim register for September totaling \$26,702.10.

New Business:

Members of the Rec. Center voiced their concerns and posed several questions to the park board regarding the proposal of Eastlake Fitness to manage and add on to the current weight/fitness room. The board informed them that nothing has been decided and that is still in the talking stage.

The board approved the hiring of Wanda Peffer as Rec. Center custodian at a starting wage of \$10.25. She will be replacing Billie Ulrey who has resigned. Motion by Kreager, second by Byers. All ayes.
The board approved a wage increase for desk attendants to \$10.60 for Emily Thomas and \$10.85 for Mary Moorman. Motion by Kreager, second by Byers. All ayes.

Unfinished Business:

CCI Fund:

The board approved the purchase of a diesel mower from Gardners with \$10,000 being paid this year and the balance of \$4,200 next year from the Community Fund. Motion to purchase mower by Kreager, second by Byers. All ayes.

Other Business:



The Winter Indoor Market begins on Saturday, October 28 in the community room from 9am to 1pm.


The meeting was adjourned at 6:45pm. Motion by Kreager, second by Byers. All ayes.
