Unfinished Business:

Jason Becker conducted a presentation of the proposed Veterans Memorial. The memorial will be done in phases with the first phase costing \$257,560.00. An account will be set up at the Noble County Community Foundation for those wishing to make monetary donations. The board gave their support on the memorial plans and location in Pettit Park. The board approved the 2019 budget. Motion by Byers, Second by Kreager. All ayes.

A quote of \$3490 was received from A1 Concrete Leveling for work at the concession stand area.

The board approved the purchase of playground equipment for the ball diamond area and fitness equipment for around the track. The cost of the playground equipment will not exceed \$11,080. Motion by Kreager, second by Banda. All ayes.

New Business:

The board approved a request from Arturo Macias and Yolanda Snyder to hold a Ligonier Community Fiesta at Kenney Park on Friday, September 14 from 4pm to 10pm followed by clean up with the understanding that park rules and city ordinances will be followed. Motion by Hagen, second by Kreager. All ayes.

Alan received 2 quotes to seal, fill and restripe the basketball courts. The board approved Super Seal at \$1702. Motion by Kreager, second by Banda. All ayes.

Other Business:




