The meeting was called to order by board president Brian Hite
The board approved the minutes for April. Motion by Kreager second by Hagen. All ayes.

Unfinished Business:

Mayor Fisel informed the board that after reviewing applications she a recommendation for an appointment of the position of park superintendant. A suggestion was made by Alan to create a position of Director of Park Maintenance instead of Park Superintendant. This would eliminate the need of a candidate to hold a degree in parks & recreation.

The board requested talking with the proposed candidate before the Mayor makes her appointment.

The board approved a quote from Cletus Mast for \$400 to repair the Kenney Park entrance sign posts and a quote of \$3200 from Fashion Farm for landscaping the park entrance.

New Business:

The board reviewed quotes for sealing at Kenney Park. Vanamsel was approved with a bid of \$5160.
Motion by Vargas, second by Hagen. All ayes

Quotes were reviewed for paving at Woodlawn garage area, Ruth Stultz pre-school parking lot and Kenney Park walking path to diamonds. The board approved the bid from Pulvers for \$38,600. Motion by Banda, second by Kreager. All ayes.

The board approved replacing the split rail wood fence in Kenney park with parking blocks at a cost of \$2236.
Motion by Kreager, second by Vargas. All ayes.

Other Business:



Senior Fitness class has 15 and Aerobics has 16 participants.


The meeting was adjourned at 6:40pm. Motion by Vargas, second by Kreager. All ayes.
