**A Resolution of the Logansport
Parks and Recreation Board to Transfer
Heritage Preservation Park to the City of Logansport**

WHEREAS, The Logansport Parks & Recreation Board governs the facilities within the Logansport Parks Department as provided by the Logansport City Council Ordinance 2025-01; and

WHEREAS, the Logansport Parks & Recreation Board in parks was encouraged by the City Administration to reduce current park properties as other significant properties became our responsibility to care and maintain, e.g., Iron Horse Park; and

WHEREAS, Parks Board Resolution 2021-18 declared Heritage Preservation Park as surplus property at the November 10th, 2021 Parks Board Meeting; and

WHEREAS, the Cass County Community Foundation has been awarded a \$5 Million grant to improve and beautify the adjacent Farmer's Market Lot, that includes a commercial kitchen which requires additional space to construct; and

WHEREAS, the Immigrant Statue at Heritage Preservation Park is the responsibility of a private group of donors to maintain and care for, and is not the responsibility of the Logansport Parks & Recreation Department.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by The Logansport Parks & Recreation Board of the City of Logansport that:

SECTION 1: The Logansport Parks & Recreation Board agrees to transfer Heritage Preservation Park and all property rights and obligations to the "City of Logansport" for the purpose of improving and beautifying the Farmer's Market by the Cass County Community Foundation. See Exhibit A.

SECTION 2: The Logansport Parks & Recreation Department will dismantle the Heritage Preservation Park Water Fountain to be serviced and constructed in an alternate undetermined location. In addition, the granite markers, picnic tables, benches, trash cans, and flower pots shall be removed and relocated as well.

SECTION 3: A Memo of Understanding shall be established by the City of Logansport with the donors of the Immigrant Statue for its continued care and maintenance.

SECTION 4: The timing of this work shall be determined by the construction schedule of the Farmer's Market renovations. Parks Department Staff will continue maintenance of the property until this time.


SECTION 5: That this resolution shall be in full force and effect after its passage by the Logansport Parks & Recreation Board and the Common Council of the City of Logansport.


