to Transfer Dunwoody Park to the City of Logansport

WHEREAS, The Logansport Parks & Recreation Board governs the facilities within the Logansport Parks Department as provided by the Logansport City Council Ordinance 2025-01; and

WHEREAS, the Logansport Parks & Recreation Board was encouraged by the City Administration to reduce current park properties as other significant properties became our responsibility to care and maintain, e.g., Iron Horse Park; and

WHEREAS, Parks Board Resolution 2021-18 declared Dunwoody Park as surplus property at the November 10th, 2021 Parks Board Meeting; and

WHEREAS, Peak Community Services has requested the land for use as housing.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by The Logansport Parks & Recreation Board of the City of Logansport that:

SECTION 1: The Logansport Parks & Recreation Board agrees to transfer Dunwoody Park and all property rights and obligations to the "City of Logansport" for the purpose of providing housing for Peak Community Services.

SECTION 2: The timing of this work shall be determined by the construction schedule of the Peak Community Services Project. Parks Department Staff will continue maintenance of the property until this time.

SECTION 3: That this resolution shall be in full force and effect after its passage by the Logansport Parks & Recreation Board and the Common Council of the City of Logansport.






