WHEREAS, The Logansport Parks & Recreation Board governs the facilities within the Logansport Parks Department as provided by the Logansport City Council Ordinance 2025-01;

WHEREAS, the action plan from the Logansport Parks & Recreation Master Plan Update of 2024-2028 has detailed numerous steps to improvements for Riverside Park, including -but not limited to -additional parking, replacing the current playground with new equipment, a splashpad, a shelter, and river amenities.

WHEREAS, these development & renovation projects for Riverside Park will enhance and create new play activities that helps to promote healthy, active lifestyles for the children & the citizens of Logansport, provide ADA accessible parking for the facilities in Riverside Park, and further access to the Eel River.

WHEREAS, The Land & Water Conservation Fund (LWCF) is a federal grant program administered by the Indiana Department of Natural Resources that intends to provide a maximum of \$1 million to assist Parks & Recreation Boards for development projects which may include the building of new and/or the renovation of existing facilities for public use.

WHEREAS, The Land & Water Conservation Fund requires a 50% match, which makes it necessary to solicit an equal amount of funds locally, potentially through the Logansport Redevelopment Commission, the Logansport Common Council, and other available grants.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by The Logansport Parks & Recreation Board of the City of Logansport that:

SECTION 1: We will begin solicitation of the maximum award of \$1 million through the Logansport City Council and the Logansport Redevelopment Commission for a total of 50% matching funds.

SECTION 2: Upon authorization from City Council & the Redevelopment Commission, A grant proposal shall be submitted for The Land & Water Conservation Fund (LWCF) administered by the Indiana Department of Natural Resources with a deadline of August 1<sup>st</sup>.

SECTION 3: The maximum amount of \$1 million is requested of the grant to complete development and renovation projects at the established public park, known as Riverside Park in Logansport Indiana.

SECTION 4: This project shall include accessible facilities and amenities that are usable for persons with disabilities, with a priority on outdoor recreation facilities, historical preservation, and preservation of our natural resources.




